Monday Morning Painting.

Making an Artist Book

Thursday afternoon or Friday Morning
In the last few years Artists Books have become a recognised way in which artists can communicate. This year's winner of the Geelong Print Prize was an Artist book.

This class will explore the idea of an artist book and how you can express yourself in this medium. We will cover some basic binding methods, as well as simple printmaking techniques, sun printing, collage, and other mixed media.

Art Yarns Workshop

Using the Australian produced Landscape dyes to colour your own wools for knitting and crochet. Explore colour coordinating, making art yarns, over dyeing, found yarn or your homespun yarn. Create your own Art yarns using the spindle and stick spinning techniques. In the first session participants will need to bring a potato and cheap long handle paintbrush and if you have a spindle please bring as well. In the second Saturday we will explore all the wonderful ways to colour art yarns. Ply commercial yarns with homespun and other techniques for obtaining one of a kind yarns to be used for knitting, crochet or weaving

Session 2: Saturday November 18th, 10am to 4pm. Cost: \$100. Materials fee \$50 payable to tutor, Deb Brearley, for fleece, rovings and dyes.

Evening Drawing

This class will further develop participants' skills in observation and ability to render what they see. We will also explore other drawing media like charcoal, chalks etc. Critical appraisal of your work will be made by the tutor and peers at the end of each class.
